

## Government Decree 288/2009 (15 December)

### on data collections and data transmissions in the National Statistical Data Collection Program

By the authorization conferred by Section 26 Subsection (3)*c*) of Act XLVI of 1993 on Statistics, acting within its competence laid down in Section 35 Subsection (1)*b*) of the Constitution, the Government hereby passes the following decree:

**Sec. 1<sup>1</sup>** The scope of this Decree shall cover legal persons, organisations without legal personality, persons qualifying as individual entrepreneurs under Section 3.17 of Act CXVII of 1995 on the Personal Income Tax (hereinafter: PITA) and as primary producers under PITA Section 3.18, and the economic activity of natural persons engaged in non-profit economic activities.

**Sec. 2 (1)<sup>2</sup>** Annexes 1-13 to the Decree contain the direct data collections of the bodies of the official statistical service and their data transmissions for statistical purposes, and the categories of data that may be collected.

(4)<sup>4</sup> In the case of data collections specified in the annexes, the obligation to provide data shall be performed in an electronic way, via the relevant information technology system (hereinafter: ELEKTRA system).

**Sec. 3<sup>5</sup>** (1) The bodies of the official statistical service shall disclose the data collecting questionnaire for their data collections in Annex 1-13 on their websites by 15 December every year.

(2) Within the scope of respondents for data collections laid down in Annexes 1-13, each respondent shall be designated by the body of the official statistical service that performs the particular data collection.

(3) The bodies of the official statistical service shall notify the respondent of its obligation to provide data by 31 December every year but no later than 30 days before the deadline for the obligation to provide data.

**Sec. 4** The registration system of data collections in the National Statistical Data Collection Program shall be developed and maintained by the Hungarian Central Statistical Office.

**Sec. 5 (1)** This Decree shall come into force 8 days after its publication with the exceptions laid down in subsection (2).

(3)<sup>7</sup> Direct data collections and data transmissions for statistical purposes that must be performed in 2015 with respect to 2014 as the reference year, with the exception of data collections of registration numbers 1021, 1058, 1202, 1207, 1208, 1723, 2118, 2240, 2263, 2265, 2350 shall comply with the rules of this Decree in effect on 31 December 2014.
