

Structure of Territorial Code System

A territorial code is made up of two parts:

- a settlement identification number (positions 1-5),
- a series of grouping criteria (positions 6-50).

<i>Position</i>	<i>Denomination</i>
1-5	settlement identification number, the 5th digit of which is a CDV number
6–11	territorial index number:
6–7	county code
8-9	capital's district code
10	settlement's legal status code
11	county seat code
12-13	settlement's legal status'2005 code
14-17	district code
18-22	micro-region code
23	region code
24	statistical large region code
25-28	agglomeration code
29-31	agricultural landscape district code
32	grape-bearing area code
33-34	wine region code
