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



Sectoral dialogue and negotiation processes were established to reach agreements to facilitate the Pact by creating 11 Sectoral Working Groups:





COORDINATION PROCESS

Coordination process: November 2016 to March 2017

The document containing the foundations of the Timetable Reform Agreement was ratified on 10 March 2017

Parties involved: social agents in the sector, trade unions and employers' associations, institutional agents and individuals in a personal capacity specialising in the sector that is the subject of debate.



OBJECTIVE

110 institutions, agents and organisations signed the Timetable Reform Agreement in Catalonia on 17 July 2017.







TIMETABLE REFORM AGREEMENT: 2025 OBJECTIVE

Catalonia must have implemented the rationalisation of timetables by 2025, making them more civilised and improving health and quality of life.



CHARTER OF COMMITMENTS TO THE 2025 OBJECTIVE

Correcting the two-hour time difference compared to the rest of the world

Promoting a new time culture in organisations in favour of more efficient and flexible models to meet new social needs

Establishing the concept of time as a new measure for freedom, equality and well-being



THE 2025 OBJECTIVE CONTRIBUTES TO:

Increasing the public's social well-being and protecting their health, especially that of more vulnerable groups

Allocating time more logically throughout everyday life

Achieving a greater work-life balance

Promoting activities that encourage healthier habits

THE 2025 OBJECTIVE CONTRIBUTES TO:

Improving academic performance

Increasing the amount of time available for rest


Achieving objectives regarding joint responsibility and gender equality

Promoting citizen participation in civil initiatives and organisations, as well as in the management of public affairs

Improving corporate productivity and competitiveness

Increasing workplace performance, promoting improvements in decision-making and reducing work-related accidents

GOVERNMENT ROAD MAP

Creation of the Office for Timetable Reform, to coordinate policies related to time usage.

Approval and implementation of the **Transition plan towards Timetable Reform** to fulfil the 2025 Objective of the Timetable Reform Agreement.

Awareness campaigns of the benefits of improving the timetable in the Timetable Reform in various areas (education, sports, work, etc.).

Organisation of **pilot tests** in coordination with the departments involved to assess adaptation to more rational timetables.

Support for local institutions in implementing measures that foster timetable rationalization at a municipal level.
