



Household Production (=unpaid household service work)

 Agreement (for various reasons): the SNA production boundary does not include the services produced by household for own consumption



- Household production: third party criteria
- Market producers (calculated from the top to the bottom, including operating surplus) vs. non-market producers (calculated from the bottom to the top, no operating surplus) in national accounts
- Input -method vs. output -method



Two different calculation methods

Output-method

- Comparable to market output (and market prices)
- Theoretically right option
- For example cleaning (2h): buying for 35 €/h
 - = **output 70 €** (HH-production)
 - materials and supplies 10 €
 - = gross value added 60 € (GDP)
 - consumption of fixed capital 5 €
 - wages and salaries 30 € (15 €/h)
 - = operating surplus/mixed income(25€)
- Challenge: no real data available

Input-method

- Comparable to non-market output
- Starting point: value of work
- For example cleaning (2h):
 time used 2, wage 15 €/h => 30 €
 - + consumption of fixed capital 5 €
 - = gross value added 35 € (GDP)
 - + materials and supplies 10 €
 - = **output 45** € (HH-production)
- (Some kind of) data available (but: the results depend on the chosen wage)
- Does not take into account quality or productivity or changes in those



History of calculations in Finland

- Some calculations already in 1980's and 1990's
- Active participation in work organized by Eurostat at the end of 1990's

 - Household production and consumption. Proposal for a methodology of Household Satellite Accounts. (2003) Eurostat.
- Time series since 2001:
 - Co-operation between Statistics Finland and National Consumer Research Centre
 - Data from Statistics Finland, actual calculations done by NCRC, methodological considerations and decisions together
 - Years when either Time Use Survey (TUS) or Household Budget Survey (HBS) has been conducted




HHSA calculations in Finland

- Methodology
 - Input approach = summing up the costs (does not include operating surplus)
 - Data from Time Use Survey => valuing unpaid work time by a suitable wage
 - Household production: mainly non-SNA, partly in SNA
- Main data sources
 - Time Use Survey
 - Household Budget Survey
 - Wage statistics
 - National Accounts calculations
 - Registers (for example on taxes and social transfers)




Data sources for Finnish calculations



- + Annual National Accounts calculations
- + Annual wage data
- + Annual register data

The differences between Finnish method and the UNECE manual

FINLAND


- Household work for 10 and older
- Travel time and management divided for principal functions
- Includes voluntary work and travelling related to that
- Investments include also some semi-durables (like cutlery and dishes)
- Calculations done by household types, not by gender

UNECE manual

- Household work for 15 and older
- Travel time and management separately beside principal functions
- Voluntary work and travelling related to that excluded (can be examined separately)
- All semi-durables are considered as intermediate consumption
- Separate calculations for household work for women and men recommended




Value of non-SNA HH-production in Finland in 2012 according to different methods

The future of HHSA in Finland

- The National Consumer Research Centre nowadays part of the University of Helsinki => Statistics Finland has taken the whole responsibility of the satellite (renamed as "Value of Household Production")
- Household Budget Survey 2016 => Household Satellite Accounts calculations 2016 (publication 7th November 2018)
- Time Use Survey planned for 2020 and Household Budget Survey for 2021 => Household Satellite Accounts calculations maybe 2022 and/or 2023?
- Calculations according to UNECE manual (although still according to household types, not according to gender)
