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# **Child Care Strategies Among Young Mothers**

The Case of Poland













#### Motivation

- Very low fertility rate
- Low female labour market participation
- Lack of child care services (of good quality)
- ► Familializing policies recent changes push women out of the labour market (maternity leave, kosiniakowe, 500+)



### Data and identification strategy

- Polish Time Use Survey 2014
- Women aged 18-44 with children under 6 years old
- ► n=4582
- Care as primary activity
- Preliminary statistical analysis mothers with children under 1
- 2SLS joint estimation of care and work time mothers with children under 6 years




#### Basic statistics

- ▶ 55.20% of mothers having children under 6 claims usage of kindergarten
- ▶ 5.35% of mothers gets external help with childcare
- ▶ 21.56% of mothers with child under 1 year are on maternity leave


 $\rightarrow$  working and non-working mothers






### Care time

 $\rightarrow$  maternity leave takers and non-takers






# Care time $\rightarrow$ receivers and non-receivers of external care






### Care time

 $\rightarrow$  kindergarden users and non-users






# Engaged and accessible time with child $\rightarrow$ child under 1y

### Conclusions (1)

- Working mothers give more care, but the difference is relatively small
- Leave takers give more care
- ► External help in care seems to be more complementarity than substitute of care given by mothers
- Use of kindergarden/crochery does not reduce time allocated to care activities



### Conclusions (2)

- ▶ Partner increases time allocated to care (!) complementary
- ► Time allocated for childcare affects more work time than the other way around (reverse result for children under 1)
- ► Mechanisms of family and work life reconciliation still unclear → external constraints rather than chosen strategies
- Time with child vs. childcare
- Effect of kindergarten goes through time with child channel (not labour supply channel)
