



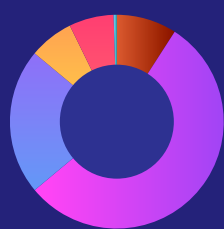
Number and distribution of population by continent, 1950–2100

The rate of population growth on Earth is gradually slowing, but the rate of population change varies from continent to continent. The United Nations predicts that, by the end of the 21st century, Africa will have six and a half times the population of Europe.

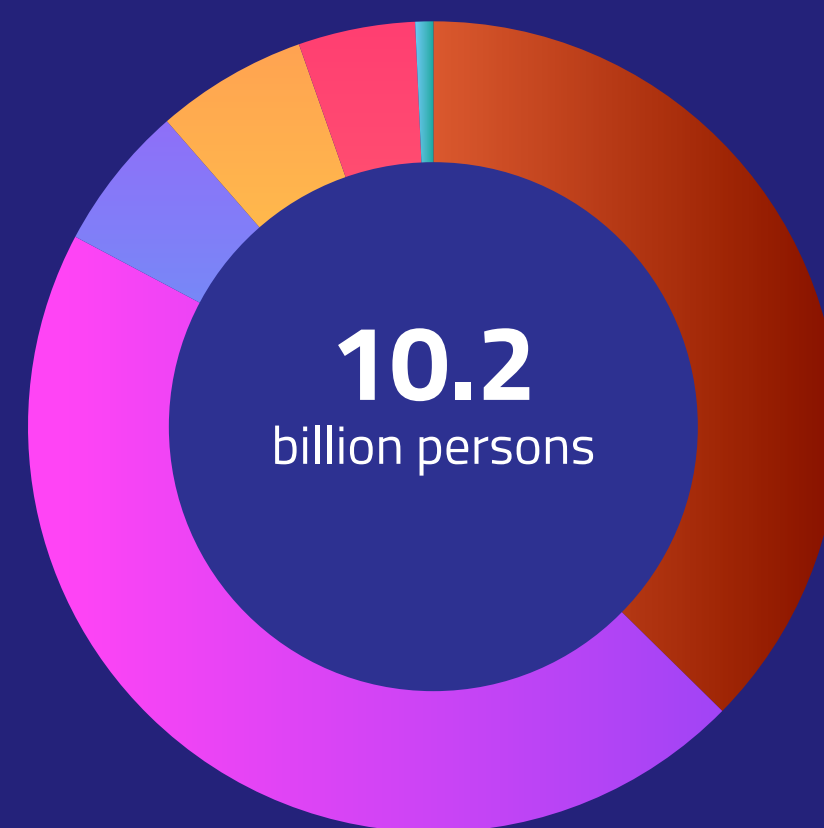
