




Number of telephone main lines, 1950–2024



Following the dynamic growth of the 1990s the number of fixed-line phones decreased by one-third compared to the turn of the millenium.



Number of mobile subscriptions and average length of mobile calls, 2000–2024




The growth rate of monthly or mobile fleet subscriptions slowed down since 2008, due to lessening calling expenses, however, the average length of calls is ever increasing.
