**Legal basis (source):**

- Commission Regulation (EC) No 656/2007 of 14 June 2007 amending Regulation (EC) No 586/2001 on implementing Council Regulation (EC) No 1165/98 concerning short-term statistics as regards the definition of main industrial groupings (MIGS).

**Implementation date (valid from):** 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008

**History of the classification:**

It entered into force with TEÁOR'98. Presently it is identical with the current version of TEÁOR'08.

**Structure:**

MIG groupings:

- Intermediate goods
- Energy
- Capital goods
- Consumer durables
- Consumer non-durables

**Short description of content:**

The Main industrial groupings (MIGs) consist of groups of branches of economic activities on the basis of end of use and function of produced products and service provided. The structure of groups of branches provide an alternative statistical breakdown of Hungarian activity classification TEÁOR'08 (which is the Hungarian version of NACE Rev.2).

**Relation to international classifications:**

The Hungarian grouping is the Hungarian language version of Main industrial groups.
