

The dynamics of the main poverty index of Hungary surpassed notably the EU average since 2010, and its level is also more favourable since 2017 than the EU average.

The proportion of those at risk of poverty or social exclusion was 1.7 percent lower in Hungary in 2023 (19.3%) than the EU average (21.0%).



According to the relative income status, as well as low work intensity, Hungary's index is more favourable than the EU average, regarding the proportion of those affected by severe material and social deprivation it is slightly below it.

Based on the most recent comparable data regarding the proportion of those affected by severe material and social deprivation Hungary is the 13th in the rank of the EU member states, coming up from the 22nd place at the beginning of the 2010s.
