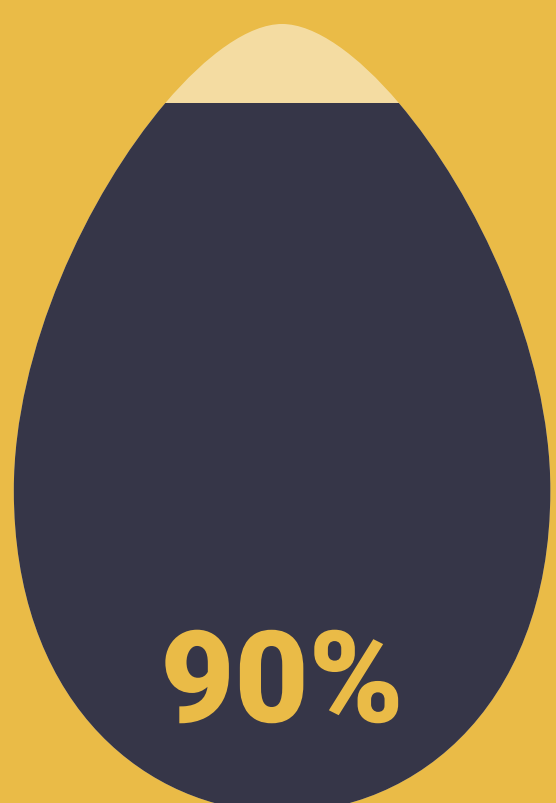


# Easter preparations

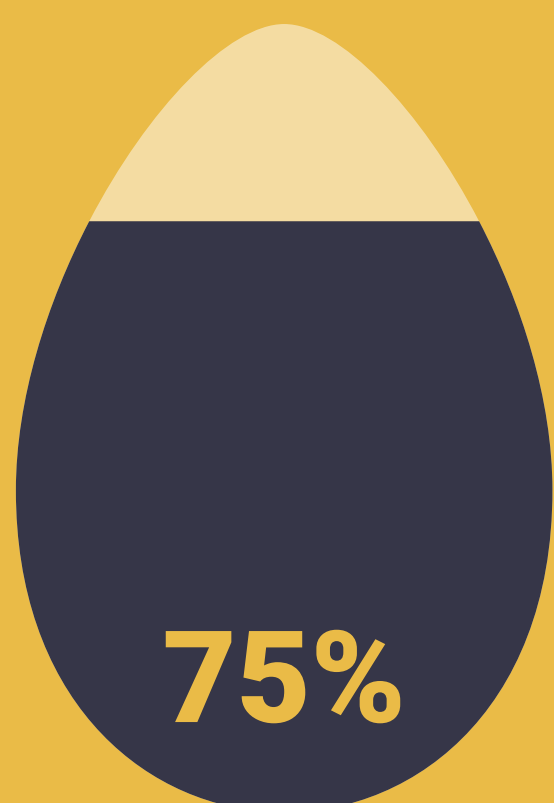

Many customs and traditions have developed and survived in connection with Easter.

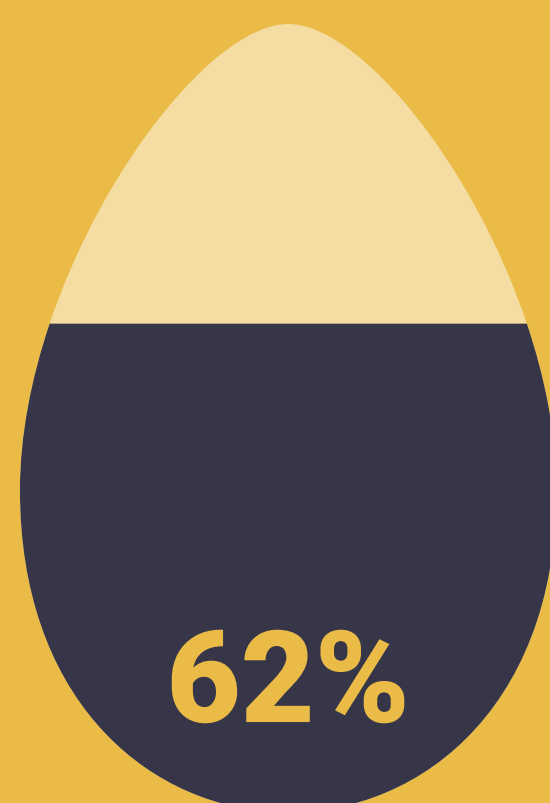
## How did the Hungarian households prepare for Easter last year?



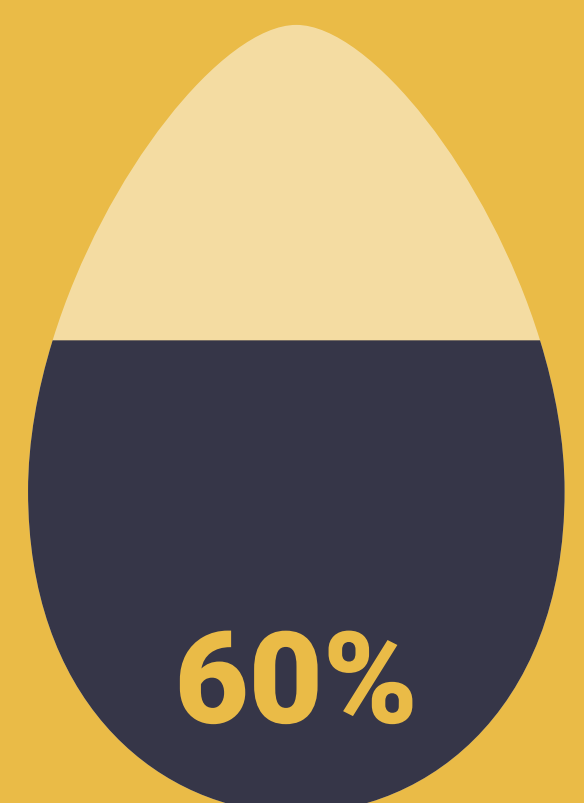
consumed ham



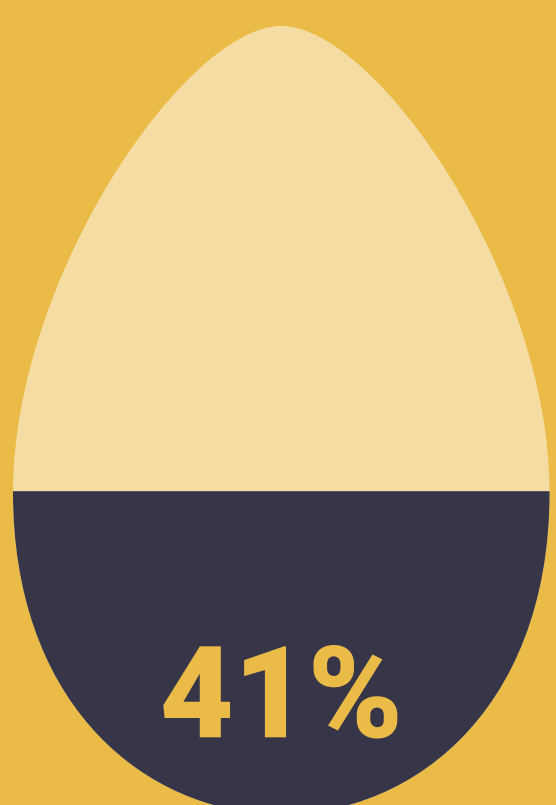
bought chocolate bunnies and chocolate eggs



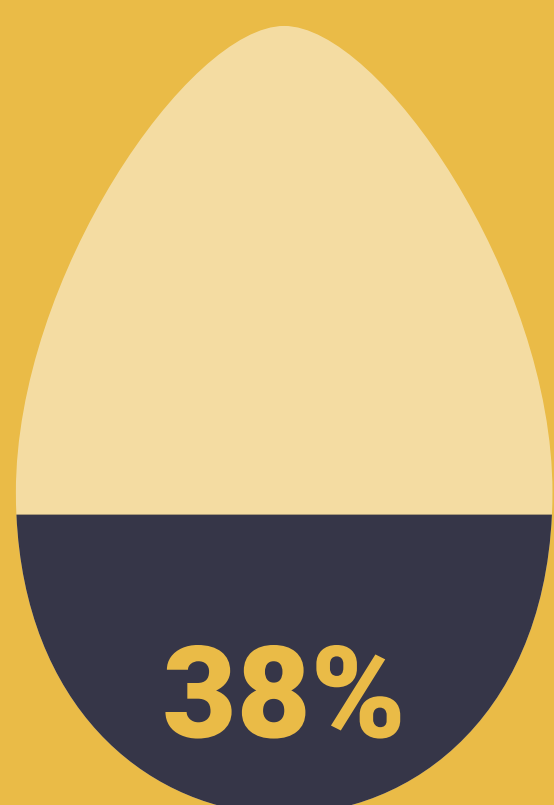
decorated their homes
