

of the EU



The V4 incorporates 37 NUTS 2 level regions (8 Czech, 17 Polish, 8 Hungarian and 4 Slovak ones). If it would be considered as one country, it would be the third most populous state and the fifth largest economy within the EU.

Median age,* 1 January 2024




The median age of the population increased in each V4 member country during the past years, being the highest in Hungary (44.5 years) the lowest in Slovakia (42.6 years) in 2024.



* The median age of a given population is the age dividing the given group into two equal parts: one being younger, the other older than the median age.


Distribution of the population aged 15–64 by economic activity, 2024



The economic activity indices of the V4 countries are more favourable than the EU average.

The proportion of those using the internet on a daily basis varied between 82–90% in the regions of Czechia, between 74–93% in Poland, 86–96% in Hungary and 83–88% in Slovakia.
